Job Summary

As Site Fitter you will be responsible for, but not limited to:

Roles and Responsibilities

- Lay out, fit, and fabricate metal components to assemble structural forms, such as machinery frames, bridge parts and pressure vessels, using knowledge of welding techniques, metallurgy, and engineering requirements.
- Undertake general workshop fitting skills including machining, burning, and welding and lifting operations.
- Read and interpret engineering drawings of various parts to ensure correct tolerance and fits are maintained for efficient operation.
- Observe tests on welded surfaces, such as hydrostatic, x-ray and dimension tolerance to evaluate weld quality and conformance to specifications.
- Inspect grooves, angles, or gap allowances using micrometre, calliper, and precision measuring instruments.
- Remove rough spots from workpiece using a portable grinder, hand file or scraper.
- Adhere to all health and safety guidelines.
- Ensure that your place of work is safe and tidy.
- Drive a MEWP or other access equipment.
